A developer wants to put a **mobile phone mast** at the junction of Charecroft Way and Richmond Way (behind the W12 shopping centre and right in front of The Shepherds Building office block).

Stark looking, It would be a massive **20 metres / 66 feet** high, totally out of place for the area.

There has **not** been proper consultation with all homes and schools within range. The application also withholds essential details.

Borough residents near masts are experiencing health problems like sleep disturbance and palpitations. Objections requested by Wednesday, 4 Jan, but please get yours in **now**.
