

DO YOU WANT A MASSIVE MAST NEAR TO YOUR HOME?

The government wants to remove your right to object. But you can stop them.



Last year, **over 400 local objections stopped an unwanted 20m (69ft) mast** in Fulham. H&F Council had to listen.

The government wants to make it easier for developers to have their masts, regardless of your views or the possible consequences, such as to health or the value of your home.

In a worst case, developers would be allowed to impose masts even where they have been heavily rejected.

Planning permission will **automatically** be given in 'green' areas. In others, planning inspectors will decide what representation you can make (if any). But you might have to be a mind reader if you don't know an application exists. The existing prominent site notice and resident letter approach will be axed and you will have to ferret for online information.

These changes will also enable much wider unwanted developments.
